

Tires & Rubber '98, Moscow

THE OPENING UP of Eastern Europe has generated new opportunities for the global tyre industry, both buying and selling.

In March, a new exhibition - Tires & Rubber '98 - will be held in Moscow, covering all aspects of the tyre and rubber industries. Around 100 exhibitors are expected, among which will be tyre, rubber and rubber goods' manufacturers, tyre retread-

ing and repairing companies and tyre and rubber goods wholesalers. The floor space will cover 6,000 square metres and the organisers anticipate 5,000 visitors, from Russia, the CIS countries and further afield.

Tires & Rubber '98 will cover much more than just tyres; among the goods and services on display, the following are expected: quality control and testing equipment, raw materials and processing technolo-

gies, manufacturing equipment such as moulds, environmental processes and control and packaging for rubber and tyre products.

As well as tyres for all sorts of vehicles and applications, the show will focus on industrial rubber goods for the automotive and other industries, anti-corrosive linings and sealants and a variety of domestic and consumer rubber goods, from shoes to toys and sports articles

to medical goods.
